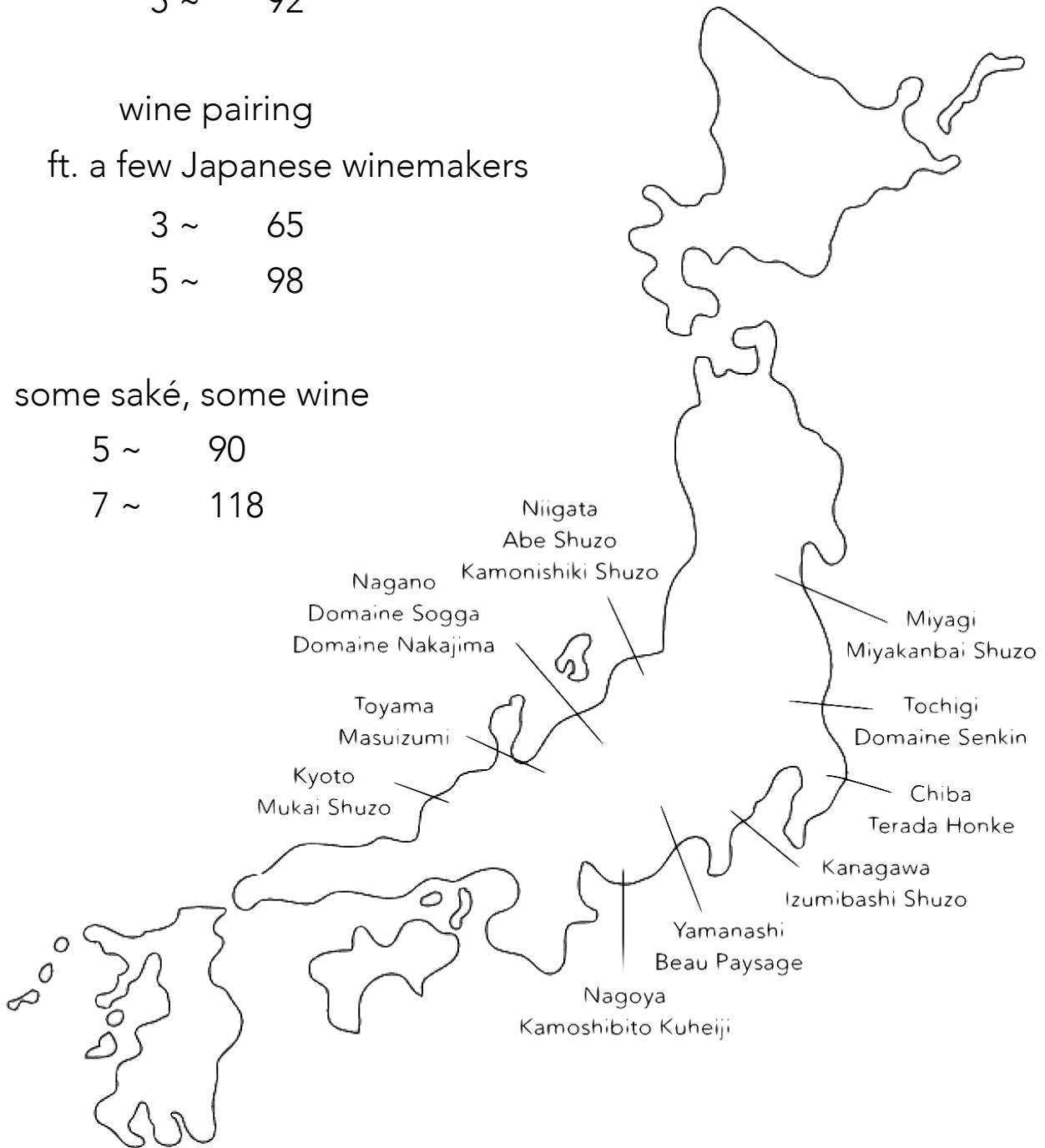

## "Domaine-style" Saké

an emerging group of tojis have started to brew "domaine-style" sakés.

This means using *sakamai*, water, *koji* and native yeasts from only their *terroir*.

Kuheiji took a step further - buying a vineyard in Burgundy to mix winemaking sensibilities.

Eishi Okamoto

Okamoto-san is a true artist. He approaches his craft spiritually and with thoughtfulness - somewhat John Lennon-esque - going as far as to commission classical and jazz albums to raise awareness for rainforest destruction.

Early on in his career, a mentor encouraged him to stay away from textbooks and conventional winemaking. Today his wines are incredibly lush and aromatic, truly one of a kind. As such, they are always sold out even before bottling. A certain 2-star French-Japanese restaurant in Tokyo secures 25% of their annual production.
